November 5, 2026 • Lyon - Embarkation • Dinner • Ama Kristina

Today is embarkation day! Perhaps you've already immersed yourself in the charm and splendor of Paris through Ama's luxurious pre-cruise extension, creating memories that will last a lifetime. Or maybe you chose to explore and savor the unique delights of another city that captured your heart (we recommend you arrive into Europe at least 1 night prior to embarkation day!). Either way, today marks the exciting beginning of your **Colors of Provence** cruise! Step aboard our exquisite ship, ready to embark on a journey filled with picturesque landscapes, vibrant cultures, and unforgettable experiences. Prepare to be captivated by the magic that lies ahead as your dream voyage sets sail.

November 6, 2026 • Lyon • Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner • Ama Kristina

Discover dynamic Lyon, starting in Fourvière Hill, part of the city's historic region that is now a designated UNESCO World Heritage Site and home to the 19th-century basilica Notre-Dame de Fourvière. Continue on to the old town of Lyon, followed by a guided walk through the St. Jean district, where you will be introduced to the city's unique covered walkways, known as "traboules." Alternatively, indulge in rich cheeses, fresh breads and charcuterie in Les Halles Market or join a guided bike tour through the city designed with cyclists in mind.

November 7, 2026 • Lyon - Vienne • Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner • Ama Kristina

On your second day in Lyon, set out on a culinary journey that will linger on your palate for years to come. Travel to the Beaujolais wine region—known as the Pays d'Or or "land of the golden stones" – to experience France's finest vintages firsthand. Indulge in a wine tasting at a traditional winery in Trevoux and learn about the history and techniques of their vineyard.

November 8, 2026 • Vienne - Tournon • Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner • Ama Kristina

Situated between the wine regions of Beaujolais and Côtes du Rhône lies Vienne with a Roman past that can be seen in its marvelously preserved ruins. Take a walking tour to see the amazingly well-preserved Augustus and Livia Temple, the Saint Maurice Cathedral, a Gothic church that took more than 500 years to build, and St. Pierre Abbey—one of the oldest surviving churches in France, and now an Archaeological Museum. For those wishing to be more active, you can either take a guided hike from the ship to the Monastery at Mount Pipet or a guided bike tour along a portion of the ViaRhôna bike route. During the evening, be treated to a delicious pairing of red wine and chocolate at the beautiful Villa Caroube.

November 9, 2026 • Tournon - Viviers • Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner • Ama Kristina

Walk through the steep vineyards as you learn about the history and techniques of winemaking in this area. Following the guided tour, join your host for a tasting of the Hermitage wines for which this region is celebrated. Alternatively, take a steam train ride past magnificent landscape carved along the Gorge du Doux stopping at the charming little station of Colombier le Vieux-Saint Barthélemy le Plain, where the train maneuvers in preparation for its return journey. For a more active adventure, take a hike through the vineyards of Tain l'Hermitage, followed by a visit to a local winery where you'll sample some of the wines. Later, stroll through Viviers accompanied by a guide in Renaissance attire as former "residents" in period costumes reenact events and legends of centuries gone by. This special historical tour is sure to bring a smile to your lips – or perhaps send shivers down your spine!

November 10, 2026 • Avignon • Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner • Ama Kristina

Depending on your interests, you have three choices of excursions for the morning. Avignon, aptly named the “City of Popes,” was the center of the Catholic Church in the 14th century when its “Palais des Papes” was the equivalent of today’s Vatican. Discover the history of Avignon on a guided walking tour that includes the Papal Palace and the well-preserved medieval walls surrounding the historic center of town, a UNESCO World Heritage Site. You can visit three venues around Avignon to taste regional specialties including macarons, cheese and wine, and tapenades or you can enjoy a bike tour. During the afternoon, you can go to another UNESCO World Heritage Site, the impressive Pont du Gard, a Roman aqueduct that is a masterpiece of ancient engineering. Alternately, you can go to the magnificent hilltop village, Grignan. After visiting this enchanting Provençal town, go in search of the highly prized “Black Diamond” truffles with a farmer and his trustworthy canine companion. Or, visit a winery in the famed Châteauneuf-du-Pape wine region, where viticulture has been promoted since the 14th century. The unique soil composition here has earned the area a reputation for producing distinctive wines that are now popular the world over. Join a specialist from the winery on a private tour of the wine cellars and vineyards, an exclusive opportunity to learn about centuries-old winemaking methods. Following your tour, enjoy a tasting of the vineyard’s specialty wines.

November 11, 2026 • Arles • Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner • Ama Kristina

Considered one of the most beautiful cities in France, Arles enchants all with its tantalizing history, formerly a Roman center of trade. In the morning, venture to Les Baux de Provence, a hilltop village and ruined castle. Enjoy time in the “old village,” its shops, art galleries, and cafes interspersed among the historic ruins. You will also have a unique experience at the Carrières de Lumières, where you will be treated to a spectacular presentation of art, sound, and history projected on the walls of a former limestone quarry set to music. Next, visit an olive farm to learn about this age-old Provençal tradition and enjoy a tasting. Finally, experience the beauty of Saint Rémy de Provence, the location where Van Gogh painted some of his most famous paintings, including *Starry Night*. Later in the day, join a guided walking tour where you’ll visit the Roman ruins of Arles such as its Roman Amphitheater and the Church of Saint Trophime, famous for its Romanesque architecture. Alternatively, you can enjoy a bike ride along the Rhône, through town to the Langlois Bridge, a famous subject from several Vincent Van Gogh paintings. And for those who wish to delve further into Van Gogh’s Arles, join a special walking tour along with a visit to the Vincent van Gogh Foundation, showcasing his legacy.

November 12, 2026 • Arles - Disembarkation • Breakfast •

Disembark the Ama Kristina full of fun memories, tasty food and wine, and wonderful experiences of Southern France. Choose to extend your stay in Barcelona, or another part of Europe, or transfer to the airport to fly back home.

CANCELLATION FEES AND PENALTIES

Notification of cancellation can be made by phone or email by the purchaser of the trip only by calling the group department at 302-278-6100.

Cancellation Schedule & Fees:

Original date of deposit to Monday July 6, 2026 - \$250 per person is nonrefundable

July 7, 2026 through August 7 2026, \$450 per person is nonrefundable

August 8, 2026 through travel dates- up to 100% of vacation package is nonrefundable

All cancellations before Final Payment will have a \$50 pp cancellation processing fee charged in addition to the above penalties. Cancellations after final payment will have a \$100 pp cancellation processing fee charged.

Premium Travel Insurance: Refunds are available for cancellations due to covered medical reasons when insurance is purchased through reliable travel insurance companies. These reputable companies offer insurance that both provides excellent coverage even when the covered medical reason might be a pre-existing condition as well as refund of out of pocket expenses while traveling (each insurance company stipulations outlined in their policy and brochure). You, the passenger, or your immediate family is responsible to file a claim with the insurance company to receive your refund of cancellation penalties for covered reasons from the insurance company. The cost of insurance is not a refundable or reimbursable item but may be able to be transferred to another purchase if the trip is cancelled without the insurance being used.

I accept it is my responsibility to review travel documentation for accuracy including name spellings, dates, and the itinerary and understand that I am responsible to contact Accent on Travel upon receipt if any information appear incorrect. I understand that changing any aspect of my travel arrangements may result in additional fees being applied to my purchase. I have been advised that the name, date of birth and gender that appears on the identification card must exactly match the same such data that is listed on my airline ticket and in my booking records. I understand that the Transportation Security Administration (TSA) requires me to carry a government-issued identification card in order to board a flight. I acknowledge that my failure to strictly comply with these requirements may result in denied boarding or an undue delay at an airport security checkpoint causing me to miss my flight. I further acknowledge that beginning on May 3, 2023, I must present a driver's license or another form of identification that complies with the requirements of the Federal Real ID Act (see www.dhs.gov/real-id for more information).

I understand that Accent on Travel is not the source or supplier of the travel services I have requested and acts solely as an agent for the actual suppliers of such services. I have been advised that the suppliers whose names have been supplied to me are those who are responsible for the travel services I have purchased. I consent to and request the use of those suppliers and agree not to hold Accent on Travel responsible should any of these suppliers: 1) fail to provide the travel services I have purchased; 2) fail to comply with any applicable law; or 3) become insolvent/bankruptcy; 4) claim a freeze on services or payments due to an unforeseen event – Force Majeure, 5) engage in any negligent act or omission that causes me any sort of injury, damage, delay or inconvenience. I understand that the use of a credit card offers me more opportunities to dispute the charge should a vendor cease operating. I accept that Accent on Travel is not responsible for, nor will I attempt to hold it liable for, any injury, damage or loss I may suffer on account of any conditions, actions or omissions that are beyond its reasonable control. I further understand and acknowledge that travel to many parts of the world may involve the risk of a variety of hazards to my health and/or safety, including but not limited to disease, crime, terrorism, and warfare. I acknowledge travel plans may be interrupted or cancelled by the supplier that is providing them, a government entity or a third party over which Accent on Travel has no control. I further acknowledge that the supplier's own cancellation, rebooking and refund policies, subject to any applicable law that is now or may later be in effect, will govern my rights and remedies, including my right to receive a refund, in such an event. I hereby hold Accent on Travel harmless and release it from any and all liabilities for any damages, including but not limited to monetary losses, I may incur as a result of such interruption or cancellation of these travel plans. Because each traveler's risk tolerance is different, Accent on Travel is not able to advise me whether I should travel to any place at any particular time. Rather, to assist me in making an informed decision, I should refer to objective third-party sources of travel information, such as that maintained by the U.S. Department of State www.travel.state.gov and the www.cdc.gov.

I understand that if traveling internationally, I must have a valid passport with an expiration date at least six months beyond my planned return travel date and, depending upon my destination and nationality, I may need to obtain one or more visas. Passport and visa information may be obtained by visiting the State Department's Web site at www.travel.state.gov. Non-U.S. passport holders should visit destination/transit embassy sites.

I understand stated price is 'locked in' when deposit confirmation is received by me or when travel is paid in full however I also understand that the cruise line tickets, airline, or other products I am purchasing may be subject to post-purchase price increases due to additional costs imposed by a supplier or government to offset increased fuel surcharges, taxes, fluctuations in foreign exchange markets or any combination thereof. I hereby consent to any post-purchase price increases. Payment for travel is due as advised verbally or in writing by Accent on Travel agent and cancellation with penalties may occur if full and timely payment is not made. Accent on Travel reserves the right to correct any errors and not bound to honor erroneous price or fees and limits liability of negligence to \$1000 or cost of resolution, whichever is less. Client agrees any disputes would be governed in and interpreted by the state of DE if mediation does not resolve the dispute.
